Pit Rim Drilling Works

In the coming months we will be conducting drilling activities at the southern edge of the Martha Pit Rim, near the

OceanaGold Moresby Avenue office and car park.

The drilling works are expected to last for around six months. During this time, the Pit Rim Walkway will still be accessible, with a small diversion in place around the work area as pictured.

Work will take place between 7.00 am and 7.00 pm, Monday to Saturday; no works will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Our usual noise and dust mitigation measures will be in place, and when drilling has been completed the area will be returned to its previous condition.
