Removing the pinion gear

As part of our processing plant upgrade, we're currently working to remove our old SAG mill to replace it with a new one. Due to its weight and size, we had to remove the mill in pieces through the roof of the building. This involved removing the girth gear in two halves (17.5-tonnes each), discharge head and feed head (38-40-tonnes each), main mill body (40-tonnes), load cell top section (9-tonnes) and the pinion (drive) gear shown above. As part of these works we've also got the largest mobile crane in New Zealand on-site. Look how small our Safety team looks standing next to it!




