We will require a copy of the bank account details for the receiving account, which also needs to be stamped and signed by your bank, as we cannot provide cheques. Should you already be enrolled but your bank account details have changed, you will need to bring a verified copy of the changes to the Project Information Office. One of the interesting parts of an industry like mining in Waihi, which has a long history behind it, is looking back at how it “used to be”.


This photograph we’ve received of the historic Martha Mine underground workings shows one of the closest things the “old timer” miners of their day had to a lunchroom.

The ever-present rat population in the tunnels back then meant that food had to be hung from the ceiling wherever possible if a miner wanted to still have a meal to come back for later. Even then, the suspended food parcels were far from 100% safe from crafty rodents. A few planks on the ground and against the wall gave the miners somewhere to sit, and that was that.

The exact date this shot was captured is currently unknown, so if anyone knows more of the details behind this photograph, please get in touch as we’d love to learn more ourselves.

Today, our underground operations look very different. Not only are the modern underground operations completely free of rats – or any type of animal – our underground staff have access to a crib room with a surprising number of modern conveniences. As well as the basic features of any good lunch area like furniture, hot and cold water, a fridge and microwave, our underground crib room comes complete with a heat pump and staff can even get Wi-Fi; 400 metres below the surface.



