

Safety Talk with Dave Oliver at Waihi College

As part of their learnings relating to health and safety, year 11 Waihi College students have been studying the Pike River coal mine incident of 2010. Dave Oliver, our Health and Safety Manager, visited the college and shared with the students how gold mining differs from coal and other types of mining from a safety point of view, as well as the different processes OceanaGold uses to ensure safety is paramount onsite.

Students then had the opportunity to ask Dave a range of questions regarding safety onsite, covering how the ventilation systems work in our underground mine, our safety protocols such as the risk assessment process, chase meetings at the beginning of each shift to discuss key details or developments from the previous shift, our emergency protocols, the refuge chambers we have throughout our operations, and how miners find their way around in the underground environment.




