Letters will be sent out shortly to all enrolled residents advising of the outcome for their property. If your property qualifies and you are not already enrolled in the scheme, we will deliver a form and instructions to enrol if you wish. We will require a copy of the bank account details for the receiving account, which also needs to be stamped and signed by your bank, as we cannot provide cheques. Should you already be enrolled but your bank account details have changed, you will need to bring a verified copy of the changes to the Project Information Office.
