If you are already enrolled in the AEP and your property has qualified for payment in the latest cycle, you should by now have received a letter confirming your eligibility and the specific payment amount.





What is a Jumbo?

A Jumbo is the mining term for a type of underground drilling machine, which is typically operated by one person with an 'offsider' assisting. While we do have some smaller, single-boom Jumbos for specialised applications, most of the Jumbos in Waihi consist of two drilling booms. These are used for two main tasks onsite; to drill into the ground to make holes for explosives, and to install rock bolts and mesh as part of ensuring new areas are safe to work in.

Operating a Jumbo effectively is a highly skilled task, with several years of experience typically needed to truly master the equipment and its applications onsite.
