Upcoming Works in the Martha Open Pit


Beginning in October, some daytime works currently occurring in the lower area of the Martha Open Pit will be extended into the night.

These works, which first began in July, are allowed for under existing consent conditions for noise, dust, traffic, and other amenity considerations, albeit with tighter restrictions for operating at night. The noise limit for night works is set at

40dB (decibels), which is comparable to background residential noises such as that of a refrigerator or computer, or the sound of light rainfall.

The Pit Rim Walkway will remain unaffected by these works, as will any other uses of the land around the Martha Open Pit.

We will keep the community informed about the ongoing progress of works, as well as any changes or milestones encountered.
