

Extension of the Correnso Mine Operational Consents

In late December 2025, the New Zealand Government passed the Resource Management (Duration of Consents) Amendment Act 2025, as part of their wider replacement of the Resource Management Act.

The Act automatically extends most existing resource consents nationwide until 31 December 2027. This is intended to bridge the transition to the new

resource management system, which is expected to take several years to develop and implement. The operating consents for the Correnso mine are affected by this law change and have been extended until 31 December 2027.

What next for Correnso?

As these changes were only announced and then legislated in December 2025, we are currently

reviewing what this means for future mine plans and operations in the Correnso area. As per the legislation, any existing conditions or limits relating to extended consents remain unchanged, so this would also apply to our Correnso operations.

We will keep the community informed as further details become available.
