

## Amenity Effects Programme Payments

Calculations for the next round of AEP payments for the period 1 July to 31 December 2025 have been processed.

Letters have been sent out to residents who qualified, advising of the outcome for their property. If your property qualifies and you are not already enrolled in the scheme, we will deliver a form and instructions to enrol if you wish.

We will require a copy of the bank account details for the

receiving account, which also needs to be stamped and signed by your bank. Should you already be enrolled but your bank account details have changed, you will need to bring a verified copy of the changes to the Project Information Office.

## Works to begin near Gladstone Hill tracks

From early March, work will begin adjacent to Gladstone Hill to install an additional water diffuser in the Ohinemuri River, alongside our existing treated water discharge system.


Once the diffuser is in place, crews will excavate a trench and lay a new pipe connecting to our Water Treatment Plant. The work will take place in stages over several weeks, depending on weather conditions.

Due to the proximity of these activities to public tracks across OceanaGold land, we may need to temporarily manage access to the area to ensure public safety. Signs will advise of any diversions or short-term closures.

All tracks affected by the works will be reinstated once construction is complete, and there will be no ongoing access restrictions.

A diffuser is essentially a pipe installed in a river, with smaller openings along it that release treated water. The openings point upwards and away from riverbanks, and the pipe does not cross the full width of the river as a precaution against impacting fish migration.

We encourage you to pay attention to the signage at track entrances and follow any posted diversions. We understand this is a popular recreation area and we will make every effort to complete the works as quickly as possible.




