Calculations for the next round of AEP payments for the period 1 January to 30 June 2026 have been processed. Letters have been sent out to residents who qualified, advising of the outcome for their property. If your property qualifies and you are not already enrolled in the scheme, we will deliver a form and instructions to enrol if you wish. We will require a copy of the bank account details for the receiving account, which also needs to

be stamped and signed by your bank. Should you already be enrolled but your bank account details have changed, you will need to bring a verified copy of the changes to the Project Information Office. ## Native Planting Gets Underway Near the Pit Rim Walkway

“Watch this space!” That’s the message from Trish at Hako Tiaki Whenua Nursery, as a new native planting project gets underway near the Kenny Street entrance to the Pit Rim Walkway.

The joint initiative between OceanaGold and Hako Tiaki Whenua Nursery will see a mix of native species planted inside an existing fenced area near the walkway. The planting will not change the Pit Rim Walkway or affect public access.

Planned species include rimu, karaka, mataī,

tōtara, kahikatea, kōwhai, karamu, tī kōuka, harakeke, wharariki, carex and toetoe.

Based at Tirohia, Hako Tiaki Whenua Nursery has been operating for five years and specialises in locally grown native plants for the Hauraki District, including wetland and restoration projects.

“It’s a real mix of evergreens that will come up among the slower-growing canopy trees and give them a bit of protection,” Trish says. “Eventually, it’ll be a big area of trees and native bush.”

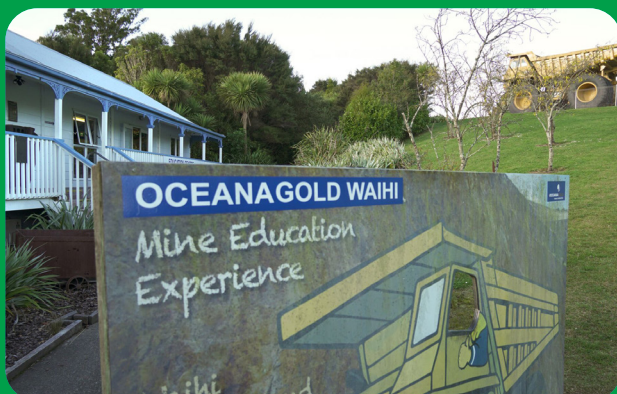


## Community Meeting - Thursday September 17th
