

## SITE TRAPPING INITIATIVE

Beginning earlier this month, the Environment team at OceanaGold Waihi kicked off our largest pest trapping programme on site to date. 50 of the 'DOC 200' style traps were placed around our Tailings Storage Facilities (TSFs) and surrounds, with the goal of reducing the numbers of stoats, hedgehogs, and

Now that we've officially entered Summer, many young pest species like stoats have matured to the point that they are actively hunting for prey. As well as targeting native birds and their eggs, or domesticated birds such as chicken and quail, stoats will even attack insects (particularly wētā), lizards, freshwater crayfish, and fish. With stoat activity most prominent in the February to April months, being able to reduce their numbers before then can make a real difference to the local biodiversity.

In addition to helping improve the native bush and farmland both on, and neighbouring our operations, this is one way we're working towards New Zealand's nationwide goal of Predator Free 2050.
