

## We are back at work

Due to the Covid-19 Level 4 lockdown, the site was closed and no mining occurred from 27 March to 27 April inclusive. We did not produce the *Martha Matters* in April.

We returned to work on Tuesday 28 April under strict conditions. A Covid-19 Management Plan has been put in place. This plan aligns with Government guidance for Alert Level 3.

Those staff who can are continuing to work from home as they have been throughout the lockdown. Operational staff have returned to site. Start and break times have been staggered to ensure that staff can maintain one metre physical distance at all times. On site vehicles have been modified to provide physical barriers between occupants. Chairs have been removed from rooms, each room has a sign at the door advising of the maximum capacity, doors have been chocked open, and hand sanitiser is available throughout the site. All staff have received an induction which details how to stay safe at work.
